What are the differences between the ISU 512 and the ISU 512e?

What are the differences between the ISU 512 and the ISU 512e?

A:

1. The ISU 512 supports Bonding Mode 1 to aggregate B channels. The ISU 512e supports Bonding Mode 1 and Multilink PPP to aggregate B channels.

2. The ISU 512 offers a control/chain in port for management and configuration. The ISU 512e provides a 10BaseT Ethernet interface for Telnet, SNMP management and for configuration. Both units can also be configured by using the front panel keypad and display.

3. The ISU 512 offers a V.35, a RS366 dialing port and a RS530 interface to connect to customer equipment. The ISU 512e presents a V.35 and RS366 dialing port to connect to customer equipment.
